### EARLY VOTING & VOTE-BY-MAIL PERIOD FOR AUGUST 31, 2021, 18<sup>th</sup> ASSEMBLY DISTRICT SPECIAL GENERAL ELECTION

#### **Early Voting**

Early Voting for the August 31, 2021, 18<sup>th</sup> Assembly District Special General Election is available beginning Monday, August 2, 2021, at the Alameda County Registrar of Voters' Office from 8:30 A.M. to 5:00 P.M., Monday through Friday. All voters who are registered to vote in the 18<sup>th</sup> Assembly District will receive a Vote by Mail ballot in the mail.

#### **Vote by Mail Period**

The Vote by Mail period for this election is from Monday, August 2, 2021, through Tuesday, August 24, 2021.

#### **Request A Vote-By-Mail Ballot**

Voters may request a Vote by Mail ballot at any time from Monday, August 2, 2021, through Tuesday, August 24, 2021, for the August 31, 2021, 18<sup>th</sup> Assembly District Special General Election by one of the following ways: completing the application on the back of their Voter Information Pamphlet, sending an email, send a written request via fax to (510) 272-6982, by mail to the Registrar of Voters' Office, or call the Registrar of Voters at (510) 272-6973, to request for a ballot to be mailed to you. Voters may also complete the online Vote by Mail application at [www.acvote.org/vbm](http://www.acvote.org/vbm). **All Vote by Mail ballot requests must be received no later than Tuesday, August 24, 2021, by 5:00 P.M.**

**Only the registered voter himself or herself may apply for a Vote by Mail ballot. An application for a Vote by Mail ballot that is made by any person other than the registered voter is a criminal offense.**
