Early Voting

Early Voting for the June 29, 2021, 18th Assembly District Special Primary Election is available beginning *Monday, May 31, 2021, at the Alameda County Registrar of Voters' Office from 8:30 A.M. to 5:00 P.M., Monday through Friday. All voters who are registered to vote in the 18th Assembly District will receive a Vote by Mail ballot.

Vote by Mail Period

The Vote by Mail period for this election is from *Monday, May 31, 2021, through Tuesday, June 22, 2021.

Request A Vote-By-Mail Ballot

Voters may request a Vote by Mail ballot at any time from *Monday, May 31, 2021 through Tuesday, June 22, 2021, for the June 29, 2021, 18th Assembly District Special Primary Election by one of the following ways: completing the application on the back of their Voter Information Pamphlet, sending an email, send a written request via fax to (510) 272-6982, by mail to the Registrar of Voters' Office, or call the Registrar of Voters at (510) 272-6973, to request for a ballot to be mailed to you. Voters may also complete the online Vote by Mail application at www.acvote.org/vbm. **All Vote by Mail ballot requests must be received no later than Tuesday, June 22, 2021, by 5:00 P.M.**

Only the registered voter himself or herself may apply for a Vote by Mail ballot. An application for a Vote by Mail ballot that is made by any person other than the registered voter is a criminal offense.
