IMPORTANT PERIODS FOR CANDIDATES AND LIST OF JURISDICTIONS FOR  
JUNE 7, 2022, STATEWIDE DIRECT PRIMARY ELECTION

The Statewide Direct Primary Election will be held on Tuesday, June 7, 2022. Nomination period for this election begins on **Monday, February 14, 2022, and will close at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 11, 2022.** In the event that an incumbent officer fails to file for re-election, the nomination period for that office is extended until Wednesday, March 16, 2022, for any eligible candidate except for the incumbent. Below is a list of important periods for candidates who plan to run for office as well as a list of jurisdictions to be consolidated with this election.

Due to the threat of COVID-19, procedures for obtaining nomination documents have been modified. Candidates for municipal offices should contact the respective City Clerk for information on obtaining nomination documents.

**IMPORTANT PERIODS**

**Signatures-in-Lieu Period:** January 3, 2022 – February 9, 2022

Period in which all voter-nominated, non-partisan (if applicable), and judicial candidates may obtain forms from county election officials for circulating petitions to secure signatures in lieu of all or part of the filing fee. Signatures may also be applied to the nomination signature requirements for office.

**Declaration of Intention Period (Judicial candidates only):** January 31, 2022 – February 9, 2022

Declaration of Intention is only required for the Office of Superior Court Judge – candidates are required to file a Declaration of Intention in order to become a qualified candidate for Superior Court Judge. The non-refundable filing fee is due at the time of filing the Declaration of Intention form.

**Nomination Period:** February 14, 2022 – March 11, 2022

Period in which all candidates must file nomination documents and their declaration of candidacy for office. The non-refundable filing fee for State and County offices is due at the time of obtaining nomination documents.

The Registrar of Voters' Office will be **closed** on the following holidays: Friday, February 11, and Monday, February 21.
